Reminders:

- Children that have immunisations will not be allowed into nursery for a period of 12 hours following, due to the risk of reaction.
- Can you also please pack your child with change of clothes for if they have a toileting accident.
- Can we please remind parents that invoices need to be paid within the first two weeks of the month. If failure to do this a late payment charge will be added to your bill on the following month. This charge will be an additional £25.00
- Parents can you discourage children from bringing in own toys into nursery. All our toys and equipment need to have a risk assessment on, and we have all toys and equipment used for activities at nursery. Comforters are fine to come in.
- Between 7.30 and 9am, and then again 4.00 and 6.00pm there is always a member of staff on the reception desk. If you need someone to answer the door in between, please buzz the office bell for someone to answer. Please can we also not answer the door to any parents or visitors, even if you know who they are. Please just ask a member of staff to.
- **Please can you now begin to provide your child with a sun hat and some sun cream.**
- If your child's details have change, for example any dietary requirement can you please inform a member of staff, so this can then be amended.
- **Room leaders are giving out new childcare agreement forms, if you can read them, sign and return asap!**
- If you have any holidays booked, can you please let a member of our team aware, so we can put this information into the diary.
- Please also can all parents ensure, you label all your Childs clothing/belongings that come into nursery. In the case of any mix ups with other children who have the same. Many thanks!
