

Week Commencing: 21st May 2012

OUR TOPIC OF THE MONTH IN TWEENIES IS:

Growing and Our Body

MONDAY

This morning the children will have the opportunity to taste some yummy fresh chives with some cheese and crackers for snack time, during this the children will be encouraged to discuss likes and dislikes. Then in the afternoon the children will be able to explore their garden area while planting different herbs. The children will also be able to enjoy some quiet time during sing and story session!

TUESDAY

Today the children will be able to make some yummy circle shaped biscuits, to decorate and take home to enjoy. In the afternoon the children will be encouraged to explore their surroundings and find different items that are yellow.

WEDNESDAY

This morning the children will have the opportunity to explore the water play are, and learn about sinking and floating. *"Demonstrate the language for shape, position and measures in discussion, for example 'ball shape', 'box shape', 'in', 'on', 'inside', 'under', 'longer', 'heavy', 'light', 'full', and 'empty'. Find out and use equivalent terms for these measures in home languages. The children will also be able to listen to the Jack and the bean stalk story and paint their hands to make leaves, to create their own bean stalk within the Tweenie room.*

THURSDAY

Today the children will be able to explore the collage material and work together to collage a circle shape. *"Make materials easily accessible to all children, to ensure everybody can make a choice." The Early Years Foundation Stage – Personal Social and Emotional Development – Disposition and Attitudes.* Then in the afternoon the children will be observed sorting the big and little maths bears into sizes, for their pathway profiles.

FRIDAY

This morning the children will be able to explore the garden area and experience fast and slow games. Within the afternoon the children will be able to freely explore the play dough using a range of tools. The children will also be able to experience a quieter session during song and story session.

At home with your child

This week within the Tweenie room the children are being encouraged to explore their surroundings and environment. To encourage this at home encourage your child to explore either the garden or the local park to collect different materials, such as leaves and twigs. Take them back in the house and create a picture using the natural collage resources collected!
